Description

As part of a multi-disciplinary team led by Cooper/Roberts Architects, LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. was retained by the City of Ogden, Utah to develop a master plan for an Intermodal Center immediately adjacent to the existing rail station in the historic downtown core. As part of this work, LSC was responsible for the following:

- Preparing an inventory of current City zoning, building, and downtown redevelopment plans that impact development of the site.
- Conduct a detailed analysis of existing and planned future transit operational requirements of the Utah Transit Agency, Greyhound, private and non-profit transit services, and the planned Wasatch Front commuter rail program.
- Develop a series of site layout circulation alternatives for both transit vehicles and private vehicles, conduct a traffic analysis of impacts on adjacent city and state roadways, and identify required roadway improvements.
- Design of transit vehicle bays and passenger loading zones.
- Analysis 20-year parking needs, and develop a series of parking lot layout alternatives.

The Ogden Intermodal Center was completed in 2002.
