**Description**

The University of Colorado at Colorado Springs contracted with ACURIX Design Groupe to update the Campus Master Plan. As part of the project team, LSC was responsible for determining the parking demand and traffic circulation needs. Key issues in the Master Plan Update were the construction of on-campus student housing, a new class room and office building, and a new humanities facility. LSC collected data to determine the existing parking demand and traffic patterns. Surveys were conducted to determine the parking lot usage and duration by type of user. This information was used to determine the future parking facility requirements and to determine the appropriate locations for those parking facilities. LSC also determined the needs for vehicular and pedestrian circulation within the campus and for access to the campus. The project also included a preliminary feasibility study for a parking structure and analysis of parking fees to pay for the future parking facilities.
