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Description

The Aspen Skiing Company proposed to expand the Snowmass Ski Area to Burnt Mountain. Working as a subcontractor to Cogan Sharpe Cogan, LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. prepared the transportation impact analysis for incorporation into the Environmental Impact Statement. The analysis included five alternatives for development of the ski area and five scenarios for off-site development in and near the Town of Snowmass Village. LSC prepared estimates of transportation demand and the impacts on the airport, the highway transportation system, and the transit systems serving the Roaring Fork Valley and the Town of Snowmass Village. Deficiencies in the transportation systems were identified, and mitigation measures were developed to offset the impacts of the proposed action.

LSC prepared the estimates of travel demand for the transportation systems using the TRANPLAN transportation modeling software package. In addition to estimating the demand, the firm used capacity analysis procedures to determine the impacts on the transportation system.
