Description

Building on the firm's previous transit plan completed in 1992, LSC Transportation Consultants, Inc. developed a Transportation Development Plan for expansion of the South Teton Area Rapid Transit (START) system serving the Town of Jackson, the Jackson Hole Ski Area, and southern Teton County. The TDP study focused on providing increased services to attain community goals minimizing growth in traffic volumes in the region. Plan elements that resulted from this study include:

- Expansion of in-town service to better serve visitors, including the provision of a visitor-oriented "theme" transit shuttle service to the Town Square area,
- Improvement in year-round service connecting Jackson with the Jackson Hole Ski Area, including development of a consistent "local" service and a streamlined "express" service,
- The development of a regional plan for park-and-ride lots and transit passenger centers,
- Establishment of a summer transit service connecting the lodging base in Jackson with visitor destinations in Grand Teton National Park, and
- Marketing and funding plans.

LSC also conducted an analysis of the impacts of transit improvements on traffic levels throughout the region. The TDP study was used as the basis of a second study conducted by others regarding long-term development of sustainable funding for public transportation services.



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
